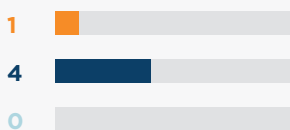


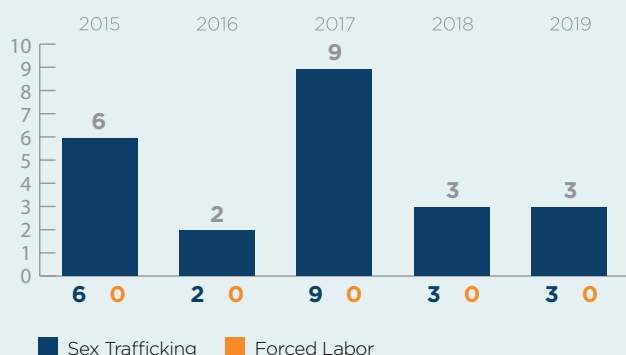

### NEW CRIMINAL CASES:

Federal prosecutors in Georgia charged **3 new criminal human trafficking cases** in 2019, ranking it 15th in the nation for number of new cases.

*National new criminal cases: 145*



### ACTIVE CRIMINAL CASES:

Federal courts in Georgia handled **14 active criminal human trafficking cases** in 2019, ranking it 11th in the nation for number of active cases.

*National active criminal cases: 606*



### CONVICTIONS:

Federal courts in Georgia convicted **5 defendants in human trafficking cases** in 2019, ranking it 19th in the nation for number of defendants convicted.

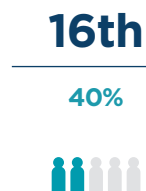
*National convictions: 339*



### RESTITUTION:

Federal judges in Georgia ordered **2 out of 5 convicted defendants to pay restitution** in 2019, ranking it 16th in the nation for percentage of defendants ordered to pay restitution.

*National restitution percentage: 33%*

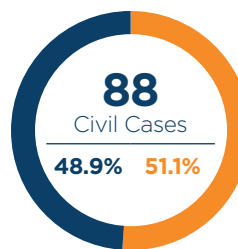

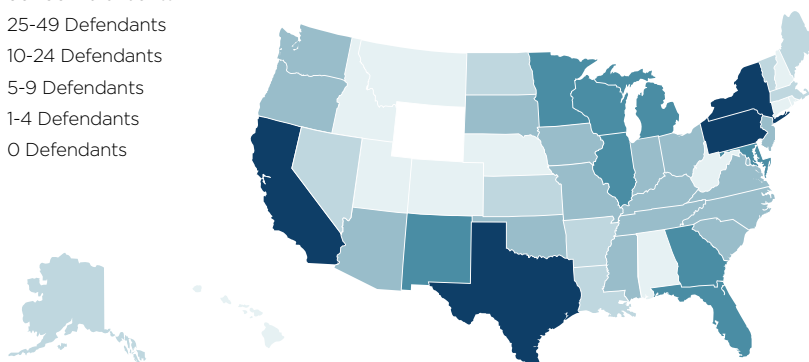
