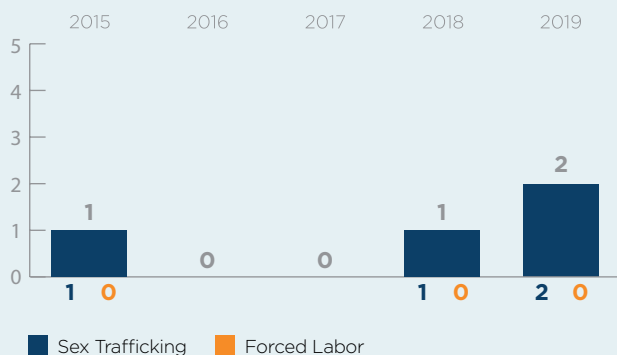




NEW CRIMINAL HUMAN TRAFFICKING CASE TREND

NEW CRIMINAL CASES:

Federal prosecutors in the Virgin Islands charged **2 new criminal human trafficking cases** in 2019, ranking it 22nd in the nation for number of new cases.

National new criminal cases: 145



ACTIVE CRIMINAL CASES:

Federal courts in the Virgin Islands handled **3 active criminal human trafficking cases** in 2019, ranking it 39th in the nation for number of active cases.

National active criminal cases: 606



CONVICTIONS:

Federal courts in the Virgin Islands convicted **0 defendants in human trafficking cases** in 2019, ranking it last in the nation for number of defendants convicted.

National convictions: 339



RESTITUTION:

Federal judges in the Virgin Islands ordered **0 out of 0 convicted defendants to pay restitution** in 2019, so it is not ranked for percentage of defendants ordered to pay restitution.

National restitution percentage: 33%

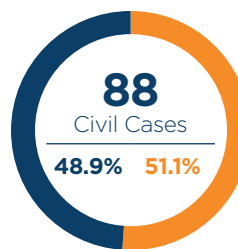

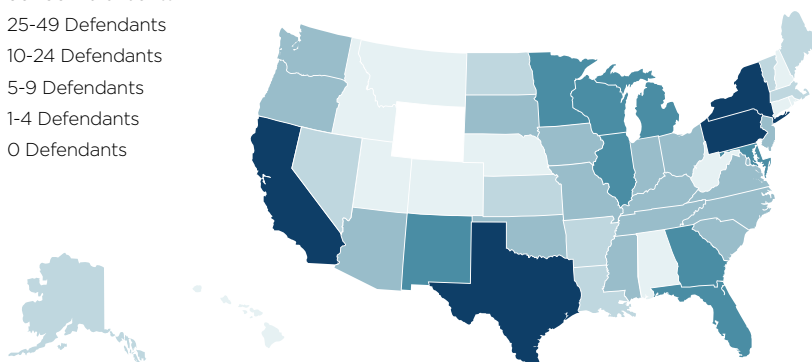
